Dallas Arboretum Presents Summer at the Arboretum, Featuring Gary Lee Price's Great Contributors Bronze Statues Exhibit, May 27 - July 31

DALLAS, Texas (Spring 2016) - On May 27, the Dallas Arboretum and Botanical Garden kicks off <u>Summer at the Arboretum</u>. The Great Contributors exhibit is a part of Gary Lee Price's renowned art collection. A fellow of the National Sculpture Society, Price has been recognized worldwide for his bold and uplifting work celebrating the human spirit. The life-size bronze sculptures are placed throughout the garden, and include Abraham Lincoln, Benjamin Franklin, George Washington, Claude Monet, Albert Einstein, William Shakespeare, Mark Twain and the Wright Brothers.

Dave Forehand, VP of gardens, added, "In the gardens, the beds are bursting with plants full of blooms like ageratum, impatiens, petunias, cleome, begonias, salvia, marigolds and zinnias. As the temperatures warm, caladiums, sunpatiens, lantana, pride of Barbados, variegated tapioca, elephant ears, coleus will be added to the gardens."

About the Dallas Arboretum and Botanical Garden:

The Dallas Arboretum and Botanical Gardens is located on the southeastern shore of White Rock Lake at 8525 Garland Road, Dallas, Texas 75218. The Dallas Arboretum is also the home of the internationally acclaimed Rory Meyers Children's Adventure Garden. The Arboretum is open daily from 9 a.m.-5 p.m. General admission is \$15 for adults, \$12 for seniors 65 and older, \$10 for children 3-12 and free for Arboretum members and children two and under. There is an additional cost of \$3 per person for entrance into the Rory Meyers Children's Adventure Garden.
