Create Memorable Moments with Moms at the Dallas Arboretum

DALLAS, Texas (April XX, 2019) – The Dallas Arboretum and Botanical Garden invites families to celebrate Mother's Day, and the first 100 moms to walk through the gates on Saturday, May 11 and Sunday, May 12 receive a beautiful, complimentary rose. Guests can enjoy live music, free wine and beer samples both days, and the Volunteer Advisory Board is on site to take family photos, available for purchase.

“We invite families to celebrate Mother's Day weekend at one of the most treasured and beautiful locations to create those memories with mothers, grandmothers and special friends,” said Mary Brinegar, president of the Dallas Arboretum.

Garden Art Exhibition:

All guests are welcome to stroll through the gardens awash with color, and experience “Celebrate the Children,” an art exhibition, presented by Reliant, on display throughout the gardens through October 15. Created by Price, “Celebrate the Children” features more than 25 different, hand-produced, bronze sculptures, many of which are of his own children. The 11-foot sculpture, “Celebration!” features joyous children celebrating life and soaring around the globe. The exhibition encourages guests to revisit childhood memories such as singing Ring-Around-The-Rosie in “Circle of Peace” with five children or playing in the grass near one of the four “Cartwheel” statues. The pieces range from 2 to 7.5 feet tall with one sculpture weighing more than 1,300 lbs. The “Celebrate the Children” exhibit, presented by Reliant, is also supported in part by The Dallas Tourism Public Improvement District.

The Dallas Arboretum and Botanical Gardens is located on the southeastern shore of White Rock Lake at 8525 Garland Road, Dallas, Texas 75218. The Dallas Arboretum is also the home of the internationally acclaimed Rory Meyers Children's Adventure Garden. The Arboretum is open daily from 9 a.m.-5 p.m. General admission is \$15 for adults, \$12 for seniors 65 and older, and \$10 for children 2-12 and free for Arboretum members and children under two.
