6" x 8" TUNNEL BOOK TEMPLATE




This template includes: (2) accordion fold sides, (4) layer templates of varying sizes, and (2) optional front cover templates.

Assuming the back layer is Layer 1, the tunnel book can be constructed with Layer 4 in the front, followed by 3, then 2, and finally 1 OR it may be constructed with Layer 2 in the front, followed by 3, then 4, and finally 1. The difference in


effect is a widening view in the first option or a more intimate view in the second option. Students may add additional cut-outs to any layer to add to the dimensional effect.

The four layers are attached to the accordion fold sides on the short end (6"). This may be done with glue or tape and varying points to provide depth.

To add the optional front cover, glue Front Cover Side A and Side B underneath the front Layer of your book, as pictured below.



Front Cover Side A and B are glued underneath top layer (either Layer 4 or Layer 2). Then fold the covers up and over the top layer.



Two-dimensional view from front layer. The back layer must be Layer 1, which is solid. The order of the other layers may be varied.






