How many tickets does it take to book a group? 15

How long is a walking tour? 45 minutes to 1.5 hours

Where do I pick up my boxed lunches? Jeanne's Pavilion

Can we reserve tables and chairs to enjoy our boxed lunches? There is open seating near Jeanne's Pavilion, Ann Stuart Courtyard, A Tasteful Place and Three Sisters Overlook

Where do we park our bus? Enter at Gate 1 and the Gate Guard will direct the bus to drop off at the ticket booth and where they can park.

Is there an additional charge for bus parking? No.

Can our group arrive at different times? Yes, but each person needs a ticket.

How much is parking? \$12 if booked in advance or \$15 at the gate. Bus parking is complimentary.

How many guides does the Arboretum provide for Guided Tours? Normally 1 guide per every 10 paid guests.

How much does a guided tour cost? \$10 per person.
